### Processing of personal data

At CAMP, we only treat personal resolutions that can be attributed to you as a user of our website, to the extent necessary. By using computercamp.dk, we typically collect the following data:

Information about your device (Tablet, mobile phone, computer or other device being used)

IP address Geographical location Visited pages and how long you visit them. If you either choose to contact us via our contact form or sign up for our newsletter and have actively consented to this, we collect the following information:

First Name Last Name Email Comments When visitors write comments on the site, we collect the data displayed in the comment form and also the visitor's IP address and browser's user agent string to help detect spam.

An anonymous string created from your email address (also called a hash) can be delivered to the Gravatar service to see if you are using it. The Gravatar service's privacy policy is available here: <https://automattic.com/privacy>. After approving your comment, your profile picture will be visible to the public along with your comment.

### Media

If you upload pictures to the site, you should not upload images with embedded location data (EXIF GPS) included. Site visitors can download and extract all site data from images on the site.

### Contact Forms

### Embedded content from other sites

Articles and pages on <https://www.computercamp.dk> can contain embedded content (eg videos, pictures, articles, etc.). Embedded content from other sites behaves in exactly the same way as if the visitor visited the other site. These sites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed extra third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with this embedded content, including tracking your interaction with embedded content if you have an account and a login to that site. At Camp we embed content from eg. youtube.

### Protection of information

The Personal Data Processing Regulation provides a framework to ensure that personal data is handled responsibly. CAMP will at all times ensure that personal data:

Treated reasonably, legally and transparently Appropriate, relevant and non-exaggerated Accurate and up-to-date - inaccurate or incomplete personal data will be corrected or deleted or further processing will be suspended Not stored longer than necessary Only processed for a specific, express and legal purpose and only treated in accordance with the purpose for which they were collected. Store safely

### How long do we keep your data

At CAMP, we use data for various functionalities on the website, and therefore we cannot specify a specific time frame for when your information is deleted, however, we do not store personal data longer than is permitted by law. The period in which we store personal data is assessed based on the nature of the information and on what background we use the information.

### Sharing personal data

Google is our help to see how you use our website and to see what kind of content you find interesting for Google to help us, we therefore share personal data with them, this data is included. use of the website, geographical location, gender and age segment, etc. to the extent that this information is known.

Likewise, we use YouTube to host our videos embedded on our site, these videos collect knowledge for YouTube.

When you sign up for the newsletter, your data is processed by a third party, but is not disclosed. We handle and send out our newsletters via MailChimp. Transmission of personal data such as name and e-mail etc. will only happen if you consent to it. We only use data processors in the EU or in countries that can provide your information with sufficient protection.

### Your rights

You have the right to access the personal information we have registered with you. You may also object to the collection and further processing of your personal data and you may, if necessary, correct your personal information. You can also ask us to limit the treatment.

We will delete or correct any information that is inaccurate or outdated when requested by the user.
